The First Aid Industry Body (FAIB) is proud to introduce the 'In Safe Hands Award' for nurseries child-care settings.

About the 'In Safe Hands Award' [\[click here to enquiry\]](#):

- The 'In Safe Hands Award' will apply to Nurseries, Pre-Schools and Childminders across the United Kingdom.
- To gain the 'In Safe Hands Award' Nurseries and Pre-Schools must achieve a MINIMUM of the following:
 - **35% of staff Trained in Paediatric First Aid (12 hour) course.**
 - **35% of staff Trained in Emergency Paediatric First Aid (6 hour).**
- Childminders and any assistants MUST been trained in the **Paediatric First Aid (12 hour)** course.

Please Note: The Department for Education (EYFS, 3rd March 2017), says at least one trained and current (12 hours) Paediatric First Aider member of staff must be deployed AT ALL TIMES within the child-care setting during opening hours and on outings.

Each childcare setting must have a 'compliance folder' that contains the following:

- A Health & Safety Risk Assessment.
- A First Aid Risk Assessment
- A First Aid Emergency Procedure Guide.
- A List of Current Paediatric First Aiders.

- The Award is renewed each year, but is *FREE for **RT Training** customers, *where we have provided your triannual first aid training requirements, and you have met the mandatory criteria (which we will support you with).
- The childcare setting achieving the 'In Safe Hands Award' will be listed in geographical areas on the FAIB website (with a website link if requested).
- The childcare setting is required to complete an annual return (showing the number and type of Paediatric First Aiders), signed by the Settings Registered Ofsted person or setting manager and confirm that the required risk assessments and procedures are in place.
- If the 12 monthly return is not completed, then the childcare setting will not be able to renew its Annual Certification and the setting removed from the FAIB website.
- An annual Certificate of registration will be sent out to the childcare facility electronically.
